We are seeking a Kindergarten Assistant to work alongside our existing kindergarten staff working 9 hours, 11.15am to 2pm (including a half hour unpaid break) over 4 days per week during school term weeks.

This position would suit someone who is recently qualified or working towards their Steiner teacher training. It is offered for 1 year, commencing in Term 1, 2020.

The Kindergarten Assistant works alongside the Kindergarten Teacher in a supportive role. The Kindergarten Assistant is responsible for assisting and supporting the Teacher in delivering the Kindergarten program to the children. A Kindergarten Assistant at Little Yarra has appropriate qualifications for working in an early childhood setting, as well as appropriate training, experience or qualifications in Steiner Early Childhood Education. The Kindergarten Assistant reports directly to the Kindergarten Teacher. The Kindergarten Assistant is a Mandatory Reporter and as such carries a duty of care and responsibilities as outlined in the school's Child Safe Policy.

Key responsibilities of the Kindergarten Assistant are to:

- Support the Kindergarten Teacher in the delivery of an appropriate early childhood program congruent with the aims and methodology of Steiner Early Childhood Education
- Assist the teacher to establish and maintain rhythms throughout the day, week and seasons
- Help to maintain an environment which encourages creative, self-initiated play
- Assist with hygiene procedures and First Aid for children as required
- Assist in developing good relationships and effective communication with families
- Develop good anthroposophical practice and be willing to expand their knowledge, understanding and best practice of Steiner Early Childhood Education
- Inform the Kindergarten Teacher of any concerns, including behavioural, child safety and OHS
- Maintain confidentiality on all issues relating to children and families
- Maintain a duty of care and supervise the children when the teacher is not present
- Apply behaviour management strategies as required, including prompt and supportive responses to inappropriate or unsafe behaviour, consistent with School policies
